Y11 Examinations

- The exams season has now started!
- Most exams are taking place in the **Main Hall, O6 and O7.**
- Many of them take place over **break and lunchtime.**

Please act with **consideration and respect** for all exam candidates.

- If you see signs saying **SILENCE** or **DO NOT ENTER** – please follow that instruction.
- **Oakridge toilets must not be used** when the red sign is up.
- Please move **QUIETLY** around the school between lessons.
- Do **not** cut through the Hall even when exams are not on.
- When changing for PE please be aware of noise levels if exams are on.
- Keep noise to a minimum in the canteen.



Morning Exam Warmups

Late Buses

- If your bus is delayed, **do not panic**.
- The school will be monitoring late buses so that you do not lose time.
- Exams **start at 09:30**
- If you will be arriving after **09:30**, you are required to **hand your phone** to the **bus driver**, or **parent** if they are bringing you into school.
- They will pass it to a member of staff on arrival.
- You will be taken straight into the exam and **any missed time will be added to the end**.

Failure to attend an examination, or attending without making a genuine attempt (e.g. head on the desk), may result in:

- Being charged the **exam entry fee**
- **Withdrawal of prom invitation**
